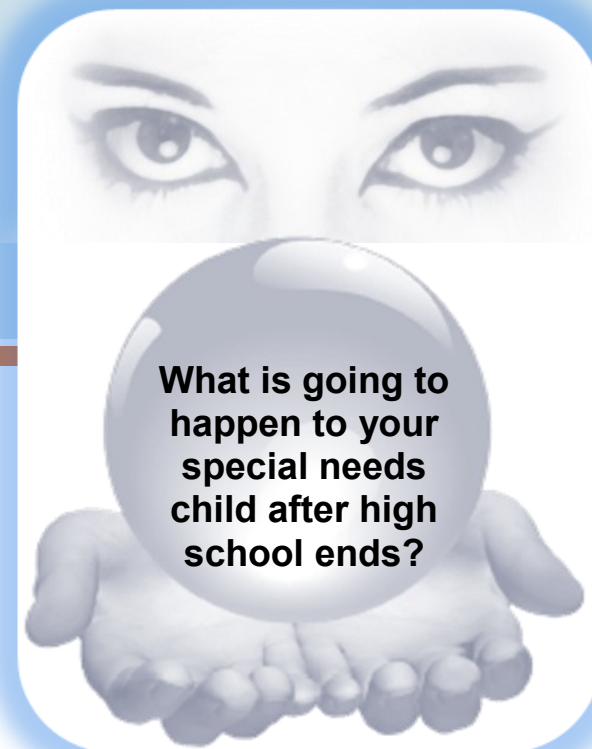


“I Matter” Conference
