A training program for individuals who are willing to become advocates for families navigating the special education process

The training is held once a year in multiple sites across the state.

Training Will Cover:

- The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act
- State law
- The Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act
- Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act

Requirements:

- Attend all 12 (3 hour) sessions
- Be willing to advocate for families through referrals by The Arc Tennessee, which will reimburse advocates.
- Fee: \$50

Locations:

The training is conducted in-person at Vanderbilt University and via video conference to other sites across the state. Distance sites must have **at least three** participants.
